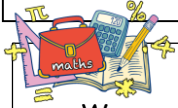




YEAR 3 - Week Beginning 15.6.20

- Our spelling learning this week is looking at words ending with the /zhuh/ sound spelt 'sure'. Use the look, cover and write sheet to practise and then test yourself with the word search.
- This week for grammar we are focusing on tenses - use the worksheet to practise your past and present tenses.
