



Planning my own Headdress

Start by thinking about what materials you have around to make it. For example, leaves from outside for feathers, scrap paper, shiny wrappers etc. What colours you want to use and how elaborate you want it to be!

Scrapbooking or planning a design board are both great ways to get your ideas down on paper.
