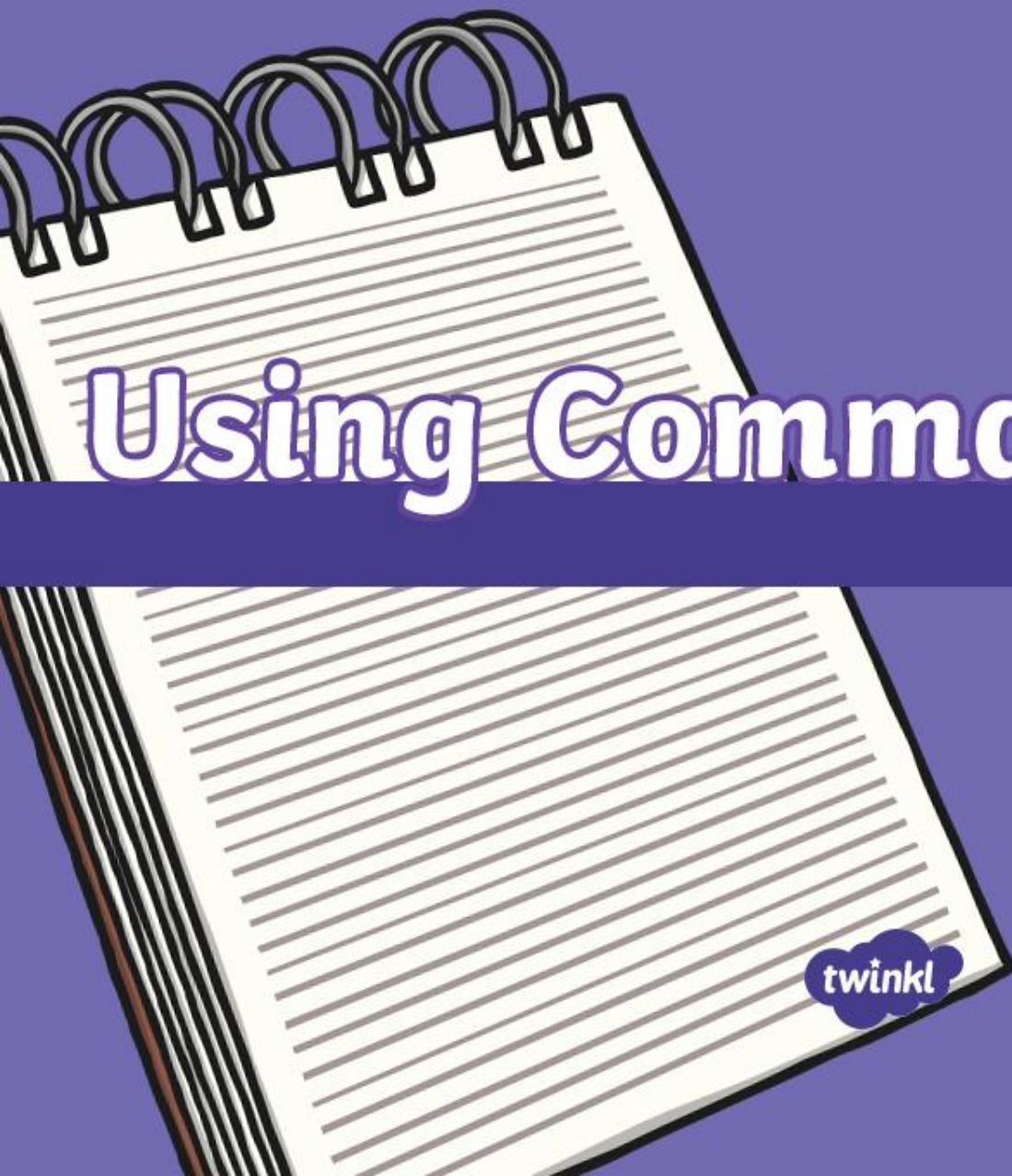


Notes for the Teacher

I love to eat fruit because it is healthy ~~and~~ colorful ~~and~~ sweet ~~and~~ delicious.

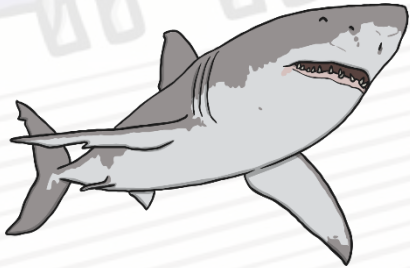

Can you describe each of these animals using a list of three adjectives? Don't forget to use a comma and the word 'and' so that your description makes sense.



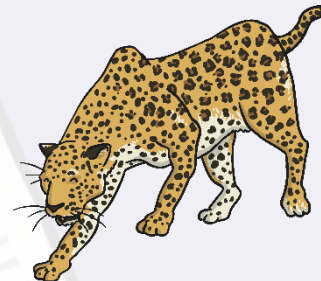

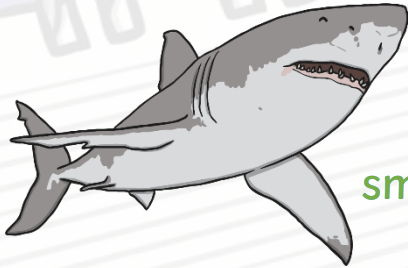

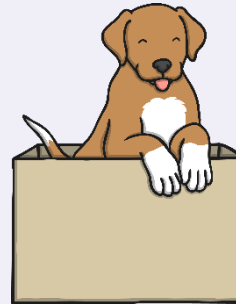

Did you spot all the mistakes?



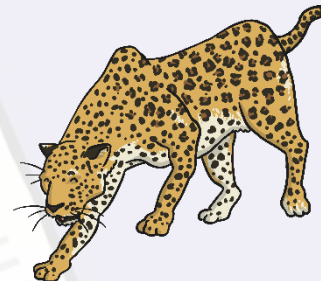

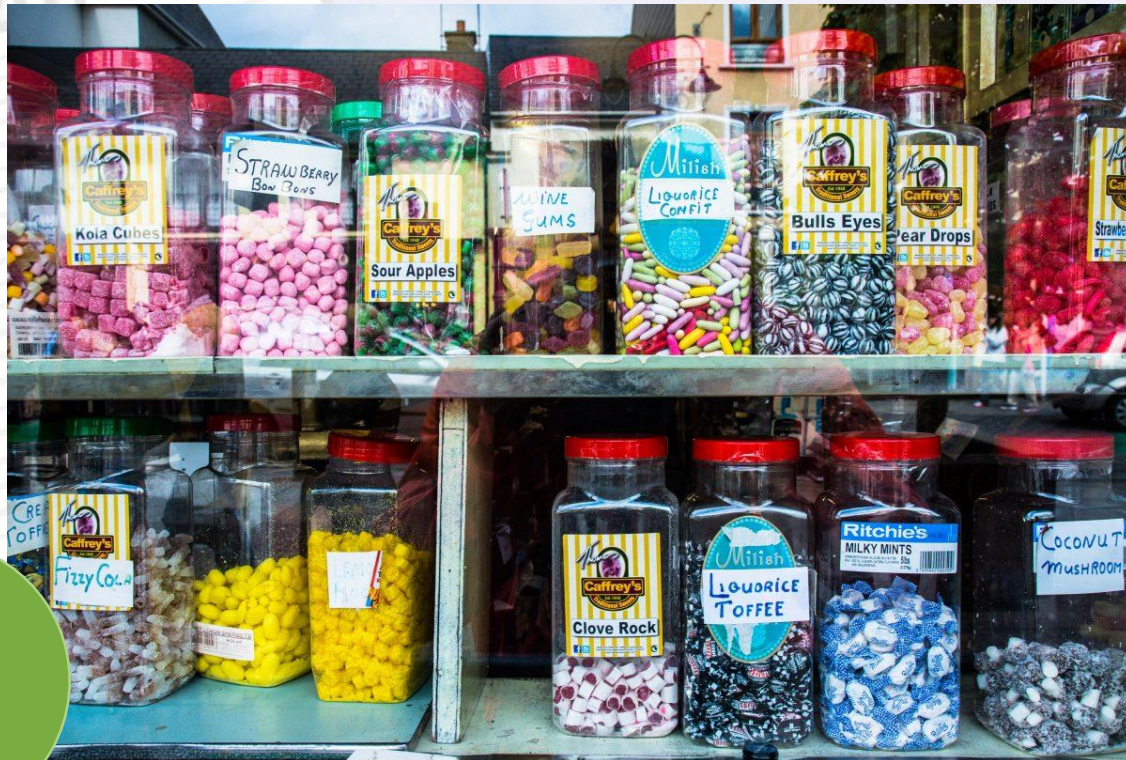
