

Matisse Inspired Coral Reef Art

You will need:

- A range of brightly coloured paper and /or tissue paper
- A large sheet of plain white paper, such as A3 paper (to use as your canvas)

Equipment:

- Scissors
- Glue



Instructions

1. Use your large sheet of plain white paper as your canvas.
2. Cut large and bold coral reef shapes from different coloured paper or tissue paper.
3. Layer and overlap these shapes onto your canvas so that they make a bright coral reef scene.
4. Next, cut out shapes of sea creatures, such as fish, starfish and octopuses.
5. Position these shapes amongst the coral reef shapes on your canvas.
6. When you are happy with your under the sea picture, use glue to stick your shapes in place.
