









LEARNING FROM HOME

Literacy	<p>Our Literacy text is 'Sharing a Shell' by Julia Donaldson</p> <p>Read the story together (you can find it on you tube- search 'sharing a shell')</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -What was your favourite part of the story? -Can you design a new shell for the crab? -Focus on learning the sound 'sh'. What other words do you know that has the 'sh' sound? Can you write them?

Expressive Arts and Design	<p>Create your own jelly fish using cupcake holders and tissue paper.</p> <p>Alternatively design your own shell for the crab using paper plates.</p>

Physical Development	<p>P.E with Joe Wicks</p> <p>Youtube- search PE with Joe.</p>
