Moving in a wheelchair with adapted alert



The adult positions themselves in front of the learner and says the learner's name to begin the interaction OR if unable to approach the learner from the front (e.g. the learner is seated at a table), approach from the learner's left side and say the learner's name to begin the interaction.

- With the pads of the fingers of the **left hand**, provide a gentle, sustained touch in a circular motion on the left shoulder while saying the learner's name.
- Leaving the left hand on the learner's left shoulder, move to stand behind the learner.
- Place the right hand on the learner's right shoulder.
- Slide the back of both hands behind the learner's shoulders and provide a sustained touch for two seconds in a downward motion.
