Punctuation Challenge

It is important to vary the way you start sentences to keep your reader engaged as well as helping you to create sentences that follow different structures. In addition to this, sentence openers can help the flow of your writing - making it cohesive.

In this paragraph, each of the sentences link to the previous and they all begin differently. The first two sentences require a comma after the first part.

- At the moment, (*fronted adverbial*)
- Since the pandemic began, (*subordinate clause*)
