



Exclamation Marks



Exclamation marks are used to indicate strong feelings or a raised voice in speech:



“Go away!” she
shouted at him.



“Help!”



Good heavens!
he said.
“Is that true?”



“What a fantastic
house you have!”
he exclaimed.



“Be quiet!”



“What a fantastic
house you have!”
he exclaimed.

Exclamation marks are also used at the end of exclamation sentences, which start with ‘what’ or ‘who’ and contain a verb.

Avoid using exclamation marks too much or they will lose their impact.
