

Treasures in the Garden Treasure Hunt

Instructions

1. Print the Treasures in the Garden Treasure Hunt.
2. Give each child a container for collecting their treasures. These could be bowls, paper bags, egg boxes or small boxes.
3. Tell the children that we are going to go on a treasure hunt and collect our own treasures.
4. Read the first item on the list out. Encourage the children to think about what 'smooth' means. If possible, show the children an example of a smooth treasure you have previously found.
5. Once the children feel confident, send the children to find a 'smooth' treasure that is small enough to fit in their container.
6. Once everyone has found an object, gather the children back together and discuss the next item on the list.
7. Continue with the activity until all of the items have been found from the list.
8. At the end of the activity, ask the children to lay out all of the objects they have found. Read through the list and encourage the children to show and describe the objects they have found.
