

HANDPRINT FISH ART



Get out your paint colours and have them ready to use along with a different paintbrush for each colour. Set out a paper towel to lay the paintbrushes on when moving from one colour to the next.

For these handprints, you could use glitter paints or any rainbow colours. After you get the design painted, have the child hold their hands so their fingers are somewhat close together (or even touching) instead of spread apart. Place the handprint sideways on the paper. Let it dry.

Make lots of prints and choose the one you like together. Enjoy the feeling of the paint and the squishing onto paper.

You can add eyes and a mouth plus any other decorations to make your fish look special.
