

Advised Timetable: Read a story every day. Practise writing your name every day or other familiar sounds. Complete a phonics and numeracy activity every day. Complete at least 1 activity from other areas each day. Take part in rhyme time every day.

Phonics Sound 'e' The rhyme for letter formation: Lift off the top and scoop out the egg. Can you go for a walk and look for things that rhyme with e? Can you practise writing 'e'?

Numeracy activity: Do you know your numbers 1 -10 Can you write your numbers, cut them out and stick them back in order?




