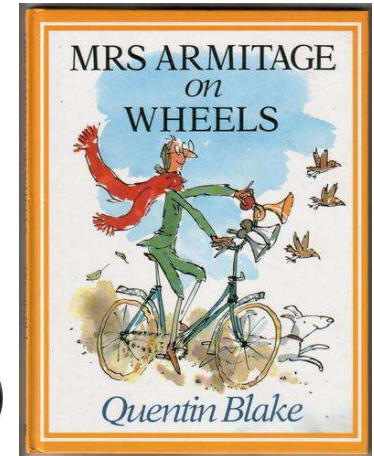

Advised Timetable:
 Read a story every day.
 Practise writing your name every day or other familiar sounds.
 Complete a phonics and numeracy activity every day.
 Complete at least 1 activity from other areas each day.
 Take part in rhyme time every day.

Literacy:
 Can you remember what the story was about?
 What transport was mentioned in the story?
 Do you have a bicycle or a scooter?
 What was your favourite part?

Expressive art and design:
 How many transport models can you make?
 Use junk modelling around the house and get creative!
 What colours will use?
 What will be inside?

Numeracy activity:
 Do you know your numbers 1 -10
 Can you write your numbers using chalk outside or on paper?
 Can you collect 10 toys from around the house?
