- **Phonics-** Try and find different words in the Phonics word searches found in the Phonics folder. You can also challenge yourself by completing the phonics crosswords. Use the clues to find the word. Remember to use **Special friends, Fred talk, Say the word.**
- **English-** This week you are going to write a diary. You can write a diary as yourself or as a fairy tale character. There is an example of a diary entry in the English folder and also some other resources to help you.
- **Remember to send in your diary entries to the KS1 email so that we can share them on our website.**
- **Grammar-** Learn how to use the prefix 'un' by completing the activities in the grammar folder. Go through the 'How to use the prefix un' presentation to help you.

- This week we are learning about Division. In year 1 we use sharing and grouping to learn how to divide numbers. Use the resources in the Maths folder to learn more about sharing and grouping.
