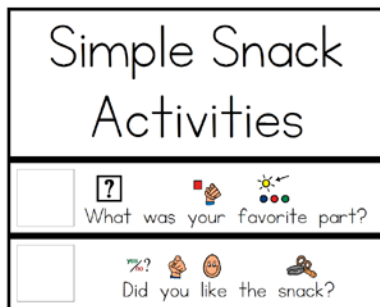


Simple Snack Activity

Basic Visuals

These visual supports can be used with all of my Simple Snack Activities.



Binder or Folder Cover and Peer Questions:

- Laminate and cut out "Simple Snack Activities" label and put on the cover of a binder or folder that can store all snack activities
- Laminate Peer Questions and add soft Velcro in empty boxes
- Make name or peer picture cards to use with questions
 - Laminate and add hard Velcro to the back of each name/picture card



Recipe Labels:

- Laminate and cut individual labels out to use for a group recipe board (a pocket chart works great)
- Write directions on sentence strips for group board



- Laminate and use visual supports for students to describe each snack



- Have students write their names under the correct picture
- You can use a sheet for each snack or laminate and reuse with a dry erase marker

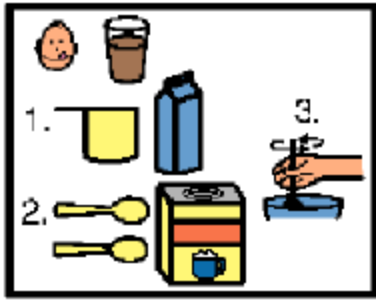

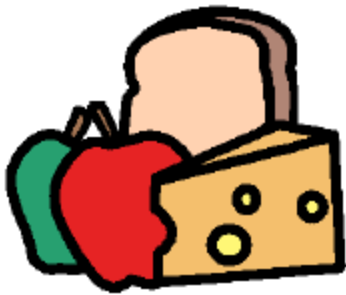

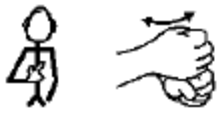
