## Maths - Week beginning 15.6.20

This week our maths focus is: **Addition.** We are going to be recapping what we have already learnt about adding and building on it. We will also be exploring other methods we can use when adding.

 Reading addition number sentences: Practise reading and solving number sentences. What does the symbol + and = mean? Use practical objects to solve some addition number sentences.



2. Using number lines: Introduce how we can use a number line as another method to add 2 numbers together. E.g.to work out 3 + 4 = find the number 3 on the number line and jump forward 4. What number did you land on?



 Counting forward: Use the number line to work out the answers to addition number sentences but this time practise counting forward from larger number. E.g. 5 + 7 =. Start by finding 7 (instead of 5) and count forward 5 steps.

$$8 + 1 = \frac{1}{0} + \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{3} + \frac{1}{4} + \frac{1}{5} + \frac{1}{6} + \frac{1}{7} + \frac{1}{10} + \frac{1}{11} + \frac{1}{12}$$
