







LEARNING FROM HOME

Reception -Week beginning 15.6.20

This term our topic is Transport. For the next two weeks we will be focusing our activities round the book 'The Naughty Bus'. See below for this week ideas for our different areas of learning.

<p>Literacy</p>	<p>Our Literacy text is 'The Naughty Bus 'by Jan and Jerry Oke</p> <p>Read the story together (story can be found on youtube.com- search 'The Naughty Bus' by Jan & Jerry Oke</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discuss what was your favourite part of the story? - Can you create a story map for the story? Where did the bus go? 	
<p>Understanding of the World</p>	<p>Create a transport experiment. Build a ramp and run different vehicles that you have down it. Which one went the furthest? Why do you think that is? Can you measure the distance?</p>	
<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p>	<p>Make a London bus using paper or junk modelling.</p> 	
<p>Small World</p>	<p>Design your own bus or car using Lego bricks or other construction toys.</p>	
<p>Sensory</p>	<p>Why not get messy? Recreate the story using buses (or other transport toys you have) and beans!</p>
