








LEARNING FROM HOME

This term our topic is Transport. For the next two weeks we will be focusing our activities round the book 'The Train Ride'. See below for this week ideas for our different areas of learning.

<p>Literacy</p>	<p>Our Literacy text is ' The Train Ride' by June Crebbin</p> <p>Read the story together (story can be found on youtube.com- search The Train Ride by June Crebbin)</p> <p>-Talk about a time when you have been on a train?</p> <p>- What did they see on their train ride?</p> <p>-What was your favourite part of the story?</p>	
<p>Understanding of the World</p>	<p>Draw and/or write about your favourite way to travel.</p> <p>What kind of transport can you see outside of your window?</p>	
<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p>	<p>Can you make your own train using junk modelling or recycling materials your find?</p>	
<p>Malleable/Fine Motor</p>	<p>Design your own train station using Lego bricks or similar construction toys.</p> 	
<p>Small World</p>	<p>Create your own small world town using toys/blocks you have at home. Can you draw the roads and train tracks? What shops might you have?</p>	
<p>Sensory</p>	<p>Have transport toys in a box with cereals/dried beans/flour. Explore the texture. What patterns can you make with the vehicles?</p>
