Oh it's hot. We need our sun lotion to protect us	Sun tan lotion	Olfactory (Smell)	Do they show awareness of the smell? Do they show like or dislike? How do they show this?
Time to cool off in the clear blue sea	Swimming movement	Vestibular	Do they tolerate their body being moved? When adult stops do they indicate through movements that they want "more"?
Time for a lovely ice-lolly to cool me off	Ice pop/lolly	Gustatory (Taste)	Do they show indication of like or dislike of the ice-pop? If so in what way? Do they indicate that they want more.
