

PULLED STRING ART

Make a pulled string art painting with paint, paper, liquid watercolours, and string.



- liquid watercolours in bright colours
- small jars or cups
- string, cut into long pieces
- a book that you don't mind getting a few paint splatters on, eg a colouring book
- blank paper

Pour your watercolours into the small jars and plop one string in each jar leaving about two inches hanging over the edge to hold onto.

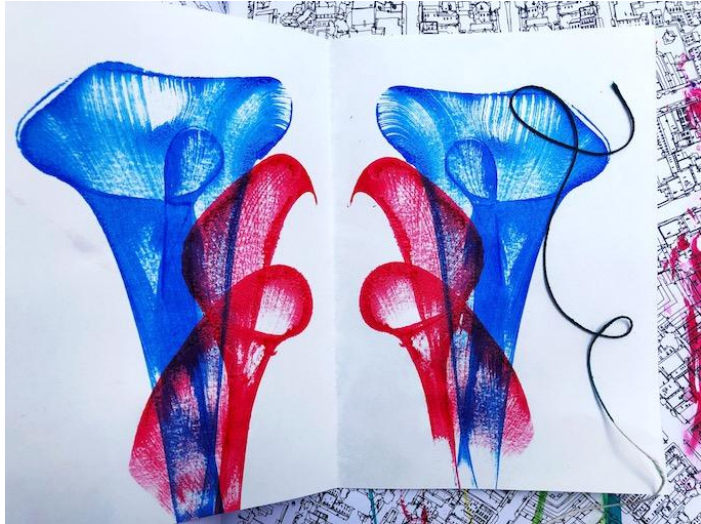
Fold your piece of paper in half and put it in the middle of your open book.

Choose your first colour, make sure the string is coated in paint, and pull it out of the jar. drag it through your finger and thumb to scrape off the excess paint.



Arrange the string on the side of your paper that will stay on the table when you shut your book. You can make loops, squiggles, whatever you want. There's no wrong way to place a string!

Shut the book and, while pressing on the cover firmly with one hand, use the other to pull that string out of the book.



You can do it all over again with a different colour on the same sheet. Repeat over and over with as many colours as you'd like and then make more and more until you're out of paint .
