



**YEAR 3 - Week Beginning 1.6.20**

- This week for grammar we will be recapping what we know about vowels and consonants. Take a look at the video and create your own acronym to remember your vowels, draw pictures next to it to help it stick in your brain. Use the example to help you.

- We will also be focusing on using the determiners 'a' or 'an' you will need to use your knowledge of vowels and consonants to help you with this.

- We are securing our knowledge of column addition with regrouping, complete the questions showing your working out neatly. Use your reasoning skills to find the answers to each challenge.

- This week we'll be learning about animal adaptations - how animals are suited to the environment they live in. Use the information to choose an environment (or create your own) and design, label and explain about an animal that has adapted to it.
