invertebrates (have NO backbone)

insects

6 legs, 3 body parts, 2 antennae, some have wings

arachnids

8 legs, 2 body parts, no antennae, sharp mouth parts, some spin webs to catch prey

crustaceans

6 or more jointed legs, often have hard outer shells (exoskeletons) and most live in water

molluscs

Soft bodies, most have external shells and some have internal shells; most live in the sea, but some live on land
