Week 1: Research

- Where are carnivals held in south America?
- How is it celebrated?
- What do people wear during a carnival? What are the costumes like? Can you describe the features of a carnival costume?
- Why are carnivals so important?
- Would you like to go to a carnival? If so explain why?

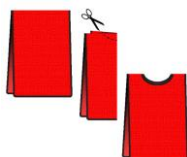
Week 2: Designing



Your task is to design your own carnival costume.

- You are going to make your carnival costume out of an old T shirt or a bin liner.
- You are going to gather some house hold items that you can use to decorate your tabard. This could be, old buttons, ribbon, recycled materials, any arts and crafts bits and bobs you already have at home! You can use felt tip pens, colouring pencils, paper, or glitter. You can be as creative as you like!
- Once you have gathered your materials, you can start to think about designing your costume.
- Draw the template in your home learning books. Remember you are designing the front and the back! Use the modelled example template to help you.
- Once you have designed it you can colour it in!
