Vegetable Garden - Journaling activity


Mr Rowell keeps running out of food, it really is time he planted a vegetable garden!


His entire back garden measures 3m x 10m.

Can you design a vegetable and fruit garden for him, a bit like the one at school? He particularly likes carrots, potatoes, strawberries, cabbage, apples and peas. Be careful with your design, he needs to be able to access all the vegetable beds by a path.

The design you draw will need to show the dimensions, area and total perimeters of each vegetable bed. You need to use colour and represent each vegetable with a colour.

Mr Rowell's class – Design in some raised beds, like the ones at school. Can you calculate the volume of soil needed as well?





Work it out first



Draw it with a ruler. Label on dimensions and add colour.

Once completed, can you share or upload the image?
Capture it using your web cam, ipad or phone, and then copy it to the bottom of this file and submit would be one way.

I'm still learning how to do this too as my children are doing their learning using Google Classroom too. So far, my technique for sharing their work is to photograph the work, email it to myself, place in a folder on my desktop, create a Google word doc, insert the image and hand in.
