This pack contains reading, Maths and Literacy activities. It is advisable that the activities are completed in the order it has been set out in the grid this is because each day builds on the learning from the previous day.

In English, the children are learning about how to write recounts. This is based on **Malala** Yousafzai who was a Pakistani activist who spoke out publicly against the prohibition on the education of girls.

In Maths, the children are dividing using visuals and beginning to understand the relationship between multiplication and division. The children are also learning about subtraction using regrouping.
