

Writing a poem instructions

This week we are going to focus on creating your own nonsense poem.

- First you need to think of something you do everyday such as brushing your teeth, making toast or getting dressed to create our draft.
- Next use bullet points to write down step by step instructions for the action. Use the word bank of conjunctions to connect the bullets together into sentences.
- Choose five words to replace with five nonsense or random words. Cross out the words and write your nonsense word above them. Remember to leave a line so you have space to edit!

- Once you have written your draft write your poem up in neat and use pictures to create a boarder.
