There will be **NO AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS** on this day.




Citizen's Assemblies

We are feeling very lucky that the school has been donated two new minibuses through the Variety Club charity programme. This means all children can continue to access our different trips and visits and travel to places further afield.




Lots of children joined in with our Book Cover Design competition before the holidays. This excellent example was designed by Annabelle Karashalis in 3M.
