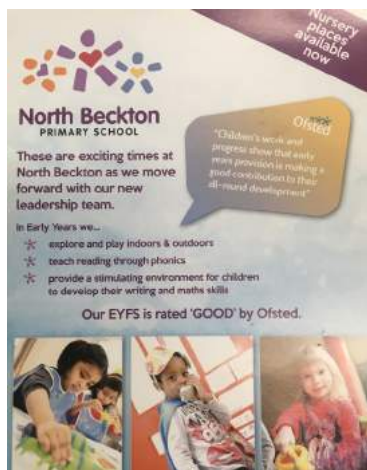
It has been a particularly pleasing week as myself and a few teachers attended the SSAT Awards ceremony in order to get the certificate to celebrate this amazing achievement.

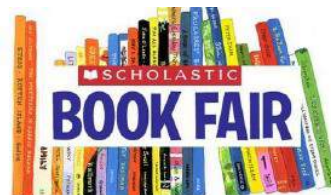

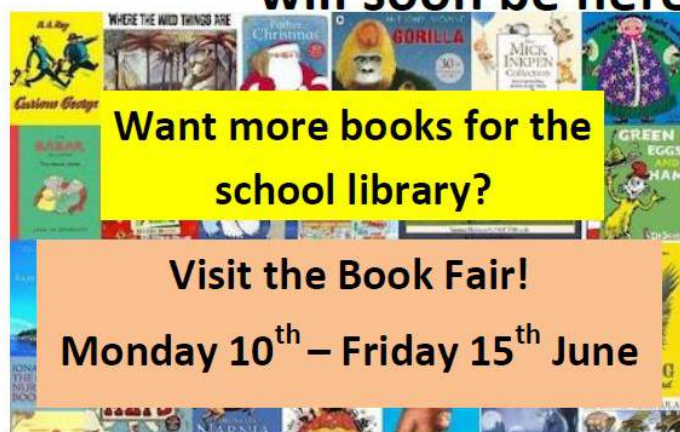
