IMPORTANT NEWS!

Well done to all the children that have been trying to come into school regularly and punctually. We have seen a positive impact around the school.

Although the government has its guidelines on absence, it is important that we continue to follow the schools policy.



Step 1

It is vital that you contact the school as early as possible on the first day of each absence, either by telephone, via the Studybugs app or in person.

Step 2

If your child is absent for more than the recommended day's then medical evidence must be provided to authorise absence (Pharmacy first slip, GP note, prescriptions, labelled medication)

Please note that if your child's attendance percentage dips without medical evidence or notification then you will be called in for a meeting. It is important that you attend any meetings or reschedule at the earliest time.

Our school target is 96.3%

Please Note!

As the New Year approaches more children will be joining our nursery. As children under the age of 5 years are not of statutory age your child's school place is based on attendance.

If your child is absent from nursery for long periods of time without medical evidence, or if you are taking them out of nursery for a holiday or any other reason that is not authorised, **then your child's nursery place is at risk.**

If the school feels that you are not using the nursery provision effectively, your child will either be changed to a different session or taken off role and put on a waiting list.

Please be mindful of this as there are children who need nursery spaces and are waiting to start.
