

Google Classroom Top Tips!

- 1. Open Google.
- 2. Search for Google Classroom
- Log in. Remember, you will need to add the email address after your username (e.g. hjenkins@northbeckton.newham.sch.uk).
- 4. Click 'Classwork' at the top of the page.
- 5. Find the relevant days' work. (E.g. Day 1).
- 6. Open up the documents.
- 7. Type your answers into a Google Docs.
- 8. Close down the Docs tab it saves automatically.
- 9. Click 'Hand In'. Once you've done this, you can still make changes to your work.
- 10. You can also make your own Google Docs or Slides and share them with your teacher!
