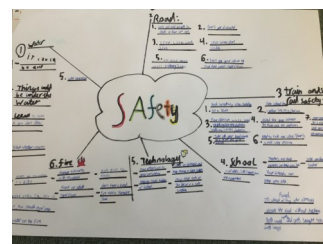

The children will be doing their tests in small groups, with their teachers and support assistants, so this will be a relaxed and 'regular' environment for them.

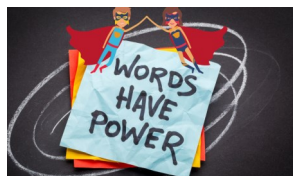
TESCO GRANT: WINNERS
