Our 'Thought for Next Week'

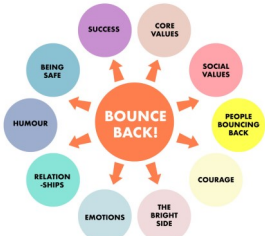
Next week, in our assemblies, we will be thinking about:
