Our 'Curriculum Logo' is a visual representation of the curriculum areas that the pupils learn during their time with us. The central figure demonstrates our priority areas, which includes embedding a Love of Reading and our Time for Us curriculum. The figure on the left extends and balances our learning into a broad base of both subject knowledge and progressive skill building. The figure on the right outlines how our curriculum develops the whole child through the incorporation of different experiences linked to our fundamental North Beckton values.

These are combined to create engaging, integrated learning within each year group covering three overarching themes throughout the year – one per term. Across the school, all the children learn about our shared histories, our current lives and our future world; our pupils will learn from our past to better understand the present in order to shape their futures.
