School renovation

A Newham school has begun renovation works which will create a space designed for students with profound and multiple learning disabilities (PMLD).

The works at North Beckton Primary, which are expected to be finished in April, will redevelop the heart of the school and form part of a wider commitment to promoting inclusivity.

The school is investing in PMLD provision and working closely with the council to provide an inclusive curriculum and facilities.

Headteacher Alison Helm said: "We are committed to making our school a place where all students can thrive with their education in a positive, supportive environment."

The renovation design will ensure the school is fully accessible for all, making the classrooms wheelchair friendly and providing specialist learning spaces for students who need assistance.

The new unit will be made up of one large classroom and multiple feeder classrooms, as well as support facilities and equipment, including a sensory room, areas for physiotherapy, child and adolescent mental health services, counselling and music therapy.
