Please take a few moments to make a note of the key dates below. We are looking forward to welcoming you into school over the next few weeks for sports days and end of year assemblies.

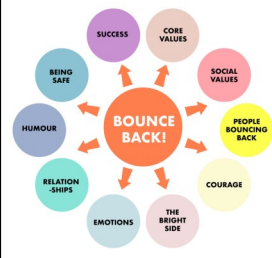
