Over the Tracks is a meanwhile use project which will create space for community activities and food growing on an unused site over the Crossrail track in North Woolwich.

Newham Council is working with Royal Docks Learning & Activity Centre (RDLAC) on this project to support the local community and food bank.

Volunteer it Yourself and the University of East London will be working with young people aged 14-25 to design and build structures on site in Sept/Oct 2023 using recycled and waste materials from the Tate and Lyle factory.
