Year 6 = Tuesday

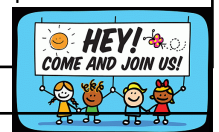
Online Parents' Evening Meetings

What do poppies represent? Why is it important that we reflect on our shared history?

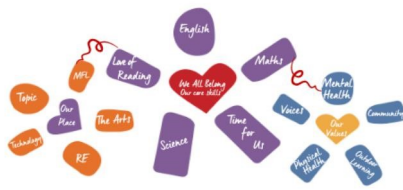


What we are learning: History Week
