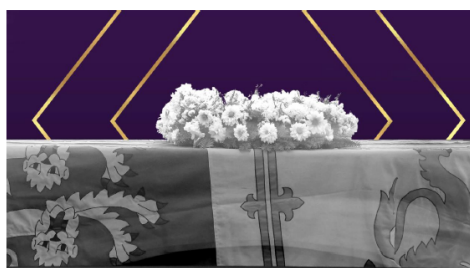


Dear Parents/Carers,

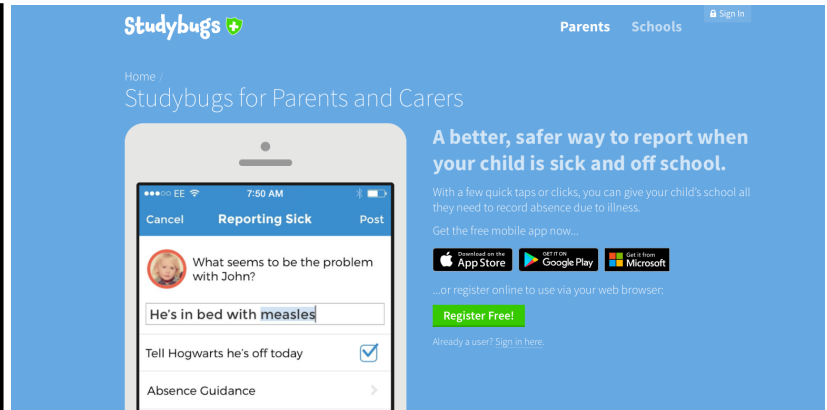
What does equality in school mean? What does equality in the wider world mean?
