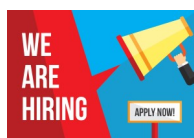
It was also an opportunity for you to meet with Mrs Lawrenson (the soon to be Executive Head of the school) and thank you for all making her feel so welcome.

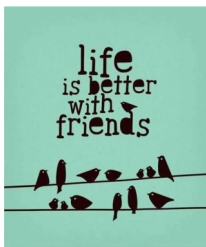
