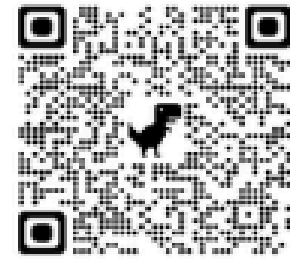
Young Artists Competition

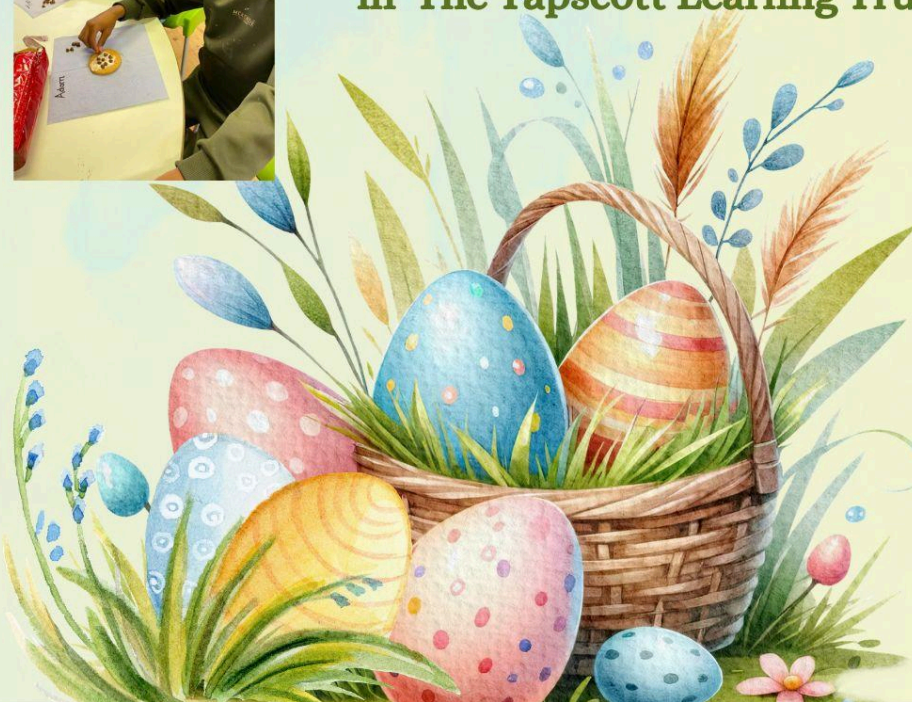
